WAIVER OF LIABILITY

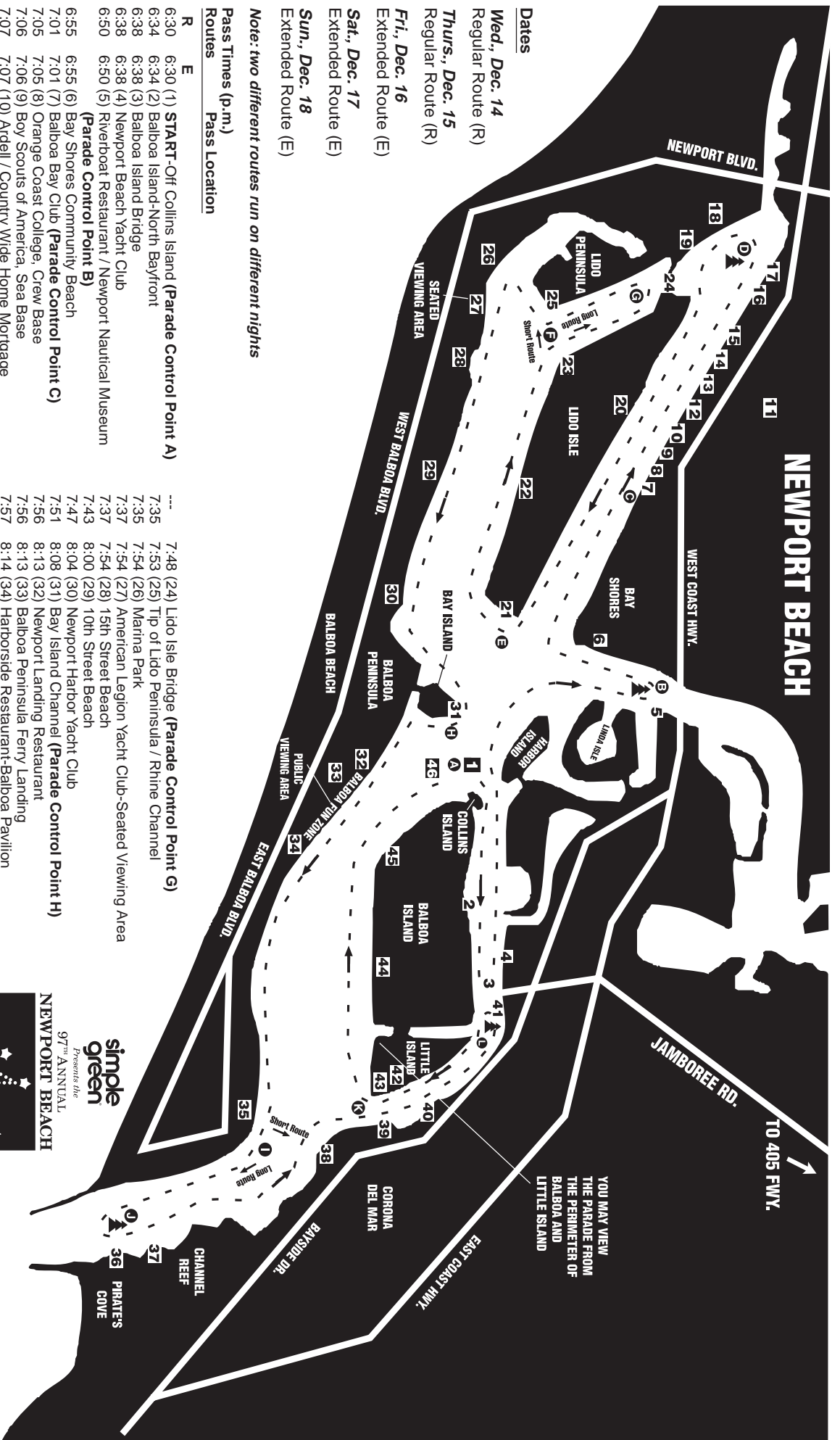

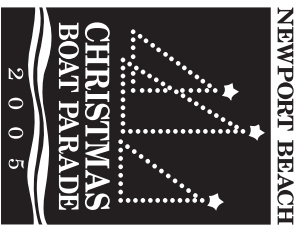
